

Presentations & Gala Awards Dinner

All teams will be invited to present their strategy and project to our judges in 'The Boardroom' in September/October 2017.

All teams wil also be invited to a celebratory evening in October 2017. Details will be provided nearer the time. Tickets will be approx. £50pp and will be available to buy individually or in tables of 10 or 12. There will be a presentation on the evening where you will see what other teams have achieved, as well as photos and footage from the challenge.

Prizes will be awarded in the following categories:

- Overall Top Team: will win a day's business consultancy with an industry leader
- Best in each category: taking into account a broad range of factors including creativity and amount of money raised
- Graduate/Apprentice Award taking into account personal development, volunteering, fundraising, company support and networking.
