

BSc/BSc (Hons) Professional Studies in Nursing: Enhancing Palliative and End of Life Care Module

Glasgow Caledonian University (GCU) offers a variety of Continuous Professional Development modules for those interested in Palliative and End of life care or working within the Palliative care sector. An example of this is *Enhancing Palliative and End of Life Care* module delivered in partnership with St Andrews Hospice. This module is suitable for a range of professions and roles and can be taken as a standalone module or as part of the *Clinical Nurse Specialist Graduate Certificate* within BSc/BSc (Hons) Professional Studies in Nursing Programme.

Module Description: This online, blended learning module will introduce students to the concepts of palliative and end of life care, appraising relevant contemporary evidence as part of this learning journey. The care and support of patients with common advanced malignant and non-malignant conditions will also be considered in the context of palliative and end of life care delivery, supporting knowledge and skill development. This helps to ensure that students underpin holistic assessment, shared decision making and care planning with appropriate evidence upon successful completion of the module.
